Introduction



Over the past few years, interest in regional anesthesia techniques has grown significantly, becoming a key component in the management of surgical, postoperative, and chronic pain.

Once primarily limited to certain disciplines such as orthopedic surgery, regional anesthesia has now expanded across a wide range of surgical specialties, thanks to the increasing use of ultrasound guidance. This technique offers a safe and effective alternative for managing both acute and chronic pain.

The integration of regional anesthesia into ERAS (Enhanced Recovery After Surgery) protocols has optimized the surgical pathway, allowing patients to return quickly and safely to their daily activities. This progress has been made possible through the synergistic collaboration of all healthcare professionals involved in perioperative care: anesthesiologists, surgeons, nurses, physiotherapists, and nutritionists, working together to reduce postoperative stress and enhance the body's response to surgical interventions.

In this context, postoperative pain management using peripheral and fascial plane blocks has become an essential component, contributing significantly to improved surgical outcomes, shorter hospital stays, increased patient satisfaction, and reduced healthcare costs.

The 30th ESRA Italy National Congress, to be held in Naples, will focus on the evolution of regional anesthesia techniques, with special attention to the use of ultrasound in pain syndromes and the challenges of hemodynamic and difficult airway management.

The event will also feature interactive sessions and discussions with other scientific societies, as well as deep dives into technological innovations that are making anesthetic practice safer and more effective in both surgical settings and pain therapy.

A major new feature of this edition will be the VOR (Virtual Operating Room)—an interactive digital space that will allow participants to engage firsthand in various clinical scenarios, with the constant support of national and international experts.

Finally, the practical workshop day will offer participants the chance to get hands-on experience with different techniques through interactive sessions. Attendees will practice identifying anatomical structures and simulate block procedures under expert guidance.

The 30th ESRA National Congress thus represents a unique opportunity for professional development and collaboration, aimed at enhancing practical skills, deepening theoretical knowledge, and promoting the adoption of the most advanced regional anesthesia techniques, all within a framework of maximum safety and scientific excellence.
