



3rd World day of Regional Anaesthesia and Pain medicine

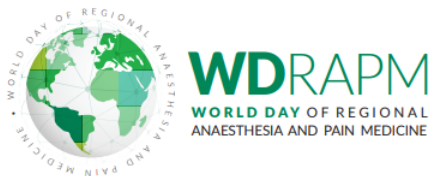
